

## Privacy Notice for California Residents

### 1. Introduction

Thermacell Repellents, Inc. (“Thermacell,” “we,” “us,” and “our”) takes your privacy seriously. This **Privacy Notice for California Residents** (“Notice”) supplements the information contained in Thermacell’s Website Privacy Policy (the “Privacy Policy”) and the Privacy Statement for Thermacell’s Products and Services (the “Privacy Statement”) and applies solely to all visitors, users, and others who reside in the State of California (“consumers” or “you”). We adopt this notice to comply with the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (CCPA) and any terms defined in the CCPA have the same meaning when used in this Notice. If you are a California resident, in the event of a conflict between the terms of this Notice and the terms of the Privacy Policy and the Privacy Statement, the terms of this Notice will apply.

### 2. Scope

This Notice only applies to you if you are a California resident.

This Notice applies only to Personal Information that we collect, but does not apply to Personal Information excluded from the scope of the CCPA. By accessing or using our website, services or products, and/or submitting your information to us, you understand and consent to our collection and use of your personal information as described herein. Should Thermacell’s stated use of your information as outlined within this Notice change, or should Thermacell begin to use your information in a manner in which is not outlined in this Notice, we will notify you.

### 3. Personal Information We Collect

We may collect Personal Information about you when you provide it to us, when we observe it from your actions or use of applicable products, when you authorize us to obtain it from third parties, or when we obtain it from publicly available sources. For example, we collect information that you provide to us when you use our website, purchase our products, or choose to receive news, updates, and alerts from us. In most cases, you will know when we collect Personal Information from you as you will actively provide it to us for a known and stated purpose. More information about Thermacell’s specific practices regarding Thermacell’s use of your Personal Information can be found in the Privacy Policy or Privacy Statement.

We have collected the following categories of personal information from our consumers within the last twelve (12) months:

D. Commercial information.	Records of personal property, products or services purchased, obtained, or considered, or other purchasing or consuming histories or tendencies.	YES
E. Biometric information.	Genetic, physiological, behavioral, and biological characteristics, or activity patterns used to extract a template or other identifier or identifying information, such as, fingerprints, faceprints, and voiceprints, iris or retina scans, keystroke, gait, or other physical patterns, and sleep, health, or exercise data.	NO
F. Internet or other similar network activity.	Browsing history, search history, information on a consumer's interaction with a website, application, or advertisement.	YES
G. Geolocation data.	Physical location or movements.	NO
H. Sensory data.	Audio, electronic, visual, thermal, olfactory, or similar information.	NO
I. Professional or employment-related information.	Current or past job history or performance evaluations.	NO

J. Non-public education information (per the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g, 34 C.F.R. Part 99)).	Education records directly related to a student maintained by an educational institution or party acting on its behalf, such as grades, transcripts, class lists, student schedules, student identification codes, student financial information, or student disciplinary records. K. Inferences drawn from other personal information.	Profile reflecting a person's preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions, behavior, attitudes, intelligence, abilities, and aptitudes.	NO

#### 4. How We May Use Personal Information

We may use or disclose the Personal Information we collect for the purposes set forth in the Privacy Policy and Privacy Statement. Our use of Personal Information may also include specific purposes of which you are apprised at the time of collection.

We will not collect additional categories of Personal Information or use the Personal Information we collected for materially different, unrelated, or incompatible purposes without providing you notice.

#### 5. How We Share Personal Information

Personal Information we collect may be shared with a third party for a business purpose, including service providers. We may share your information with our service providers solely for them to fulfill their obligations to us and on our behalf. Our service providers are not permitted to share, sell or otherwise use your information outside of their relationship with us. More specific information about Thermacell's sharing of Personal Information can be found in the Privacy Policy or Privacy Statement.

We share your Personal Information with the following categories of CCPA third parties:

1. Vendors and service providers, including for data analytics and marketing and advertising our products and services to you.
2. Third parties integrated into our services or products.
3. Third parties as required by law and similar disclosures.
4. Third parties in connection with a merger, sale, or asset transfer.
5. Other third parties for whom we have obtained your permission to disclose your Personal Information.

In the preceding twelve (12) months, Company has disclosed the following categories of Personal Information for a business purpose:

1. Category A – Identifiers.
2. Category B – California Customer Records personal information categories.
3. Category D – Commercial Information.
4. Category F – Internet or other similar network activity.

We do not Sell your Personal Information.

## **6. Right to Know**

You can request that we provide you with the categories of Personal Information we have collected from you, the sources from which we collected the information, the business purpose for collecting and/or sharing that Personal Information, and the categories of third parties with whom we have shared that Personal Information. The CCPA limits our response to how we have collected, used and shared your Personal Information over the past twelve (12) months. Information on how to submit a request to us is provided below.

## **7. Right to Deletion**

The CCPA gives you the right to request that we delete Personal Information we have collected from you. In certain circumstances, we may not delete all Personal Information we have collected from you, as permitted under the CCPA. Information on how to submit a request to us is provided below.

## **8. Submitting a Request**

We will be in contact with you to verify your identity, as required under the CCPA, before any response is provided. The CCPA prohibits discriminatory treatment of California residents with respect to exercising your rights under the CCPA.
